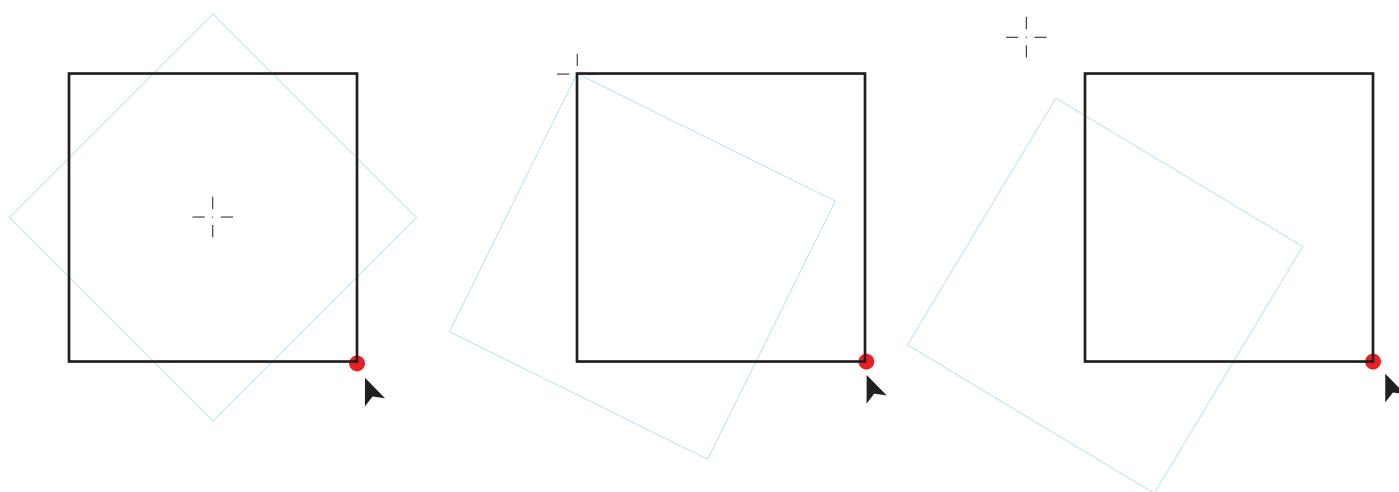


Read through all of the instructions first.

Working on the layer “Your Practice,” you’ll use the **Rotate** tool to practice three different ways to rotate the squares so they match the blue template (on the locked “Template” layer).

- 1) To select an entire ungrouped object, **Click** on it with the **Selection** tool.
- 2) With the **Rotation** tool:
 - **First click** on the cross-hair to define a “pivot” point for rotation.
 - Then place your cursor over the **red** dot and **grab** that anchor point, dragging it to match the template.
- 3) To start Choose **Rotation Lesson #1** from the **View** menu.

To Rotate part of a path, use the **Direct Selection** tool to marquee the points:

- 1) Using the **Direct Selection** tool to select drag a marquee around only those points that you want to Rotate.
- 2) With the **Rotation** tool **click first** on the cross-hair with your cursor. Then **grab** the anchor point under the red dot and drag into position.
